New Features

EDIUS

- Column widths in the Job window are now easier to change
- User profiles are now imported even if the respective folders in which the user profiles are held have been renamed

Mync

- VisTitle assets are now able to be previewed when the VisTitle plug-in is installed
- Column widths in the Job Monitor are now easier to change

Fixed Issues

EDIUS

- There is a case where clips registered in the Bin do not appear in Mync
- If the Field Order of a timeline sequence clip on the timeline is changed, the change is ignored when rendering the clip (SFDC00918931)
- “Convert File” will reset changes to clip properties like Start TC, Frame Rate, Aspect Ratio, etc.
- When moving a clip in the Mync window, there is a case where the clip is copied in the Bin window
- The Mync window layout becomes a little strange at times
- Occasionally the search category dropdown list in the Search Settings pane of the Mync window is not shown properly
- There are cases where exporting H.265/HEVC files using hardware encoder fails on some hardware
- When playing back the timeline after performing “Undo” , there is a case where a render file which should not be used is played back incorrectly (SFDC00925403)
- There is a case where resizing column widths in the Job window causes unexpected sorting
- Applying a time effect to slow down a clip overwrites subsequent clips on tracks with sync-lock unset (SFDC00927570)

Mync

- “Convert File” will reset changes to clip properties like Start TC, Frame Rate, Aspect Ratio, etc.
- When moving a clip, there is a case where the clip is copied in the Bin window of EDIUS
- The [Management] tab layout becomes a little strange at times
- Occasionally the search category dropdown list in the Search Settings pane is not shown properly
- There are cases where exporting H.265/HEVC files using hardware encoder fails on some hardware
- There is a case where resizing column widths in the Job Monitor causes unexpected sorting
